- I believed that the experience of living in a different country for a long time would benefit me greatly.*



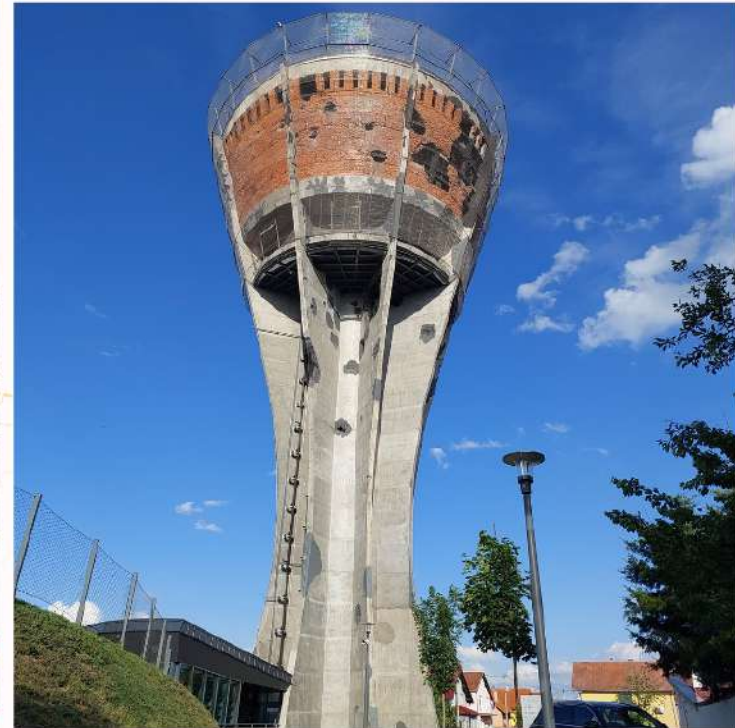
# *Why Did I Choose Vukovar?*

- I thought the climate and geography of Croatia were beautiful.*

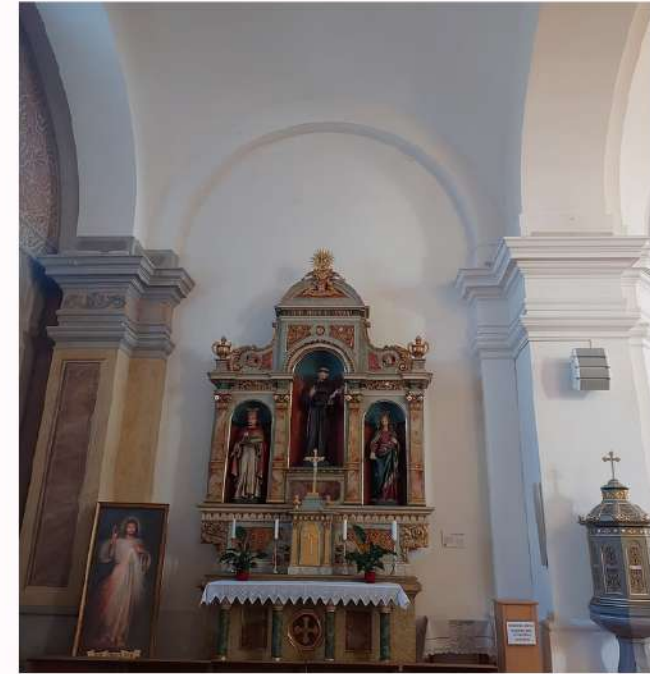
